RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BROWN COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVING AMENDMENT #1 TO THE 2017-2021 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE GREEN BAY URBANIZED AREA

WHEREAS, U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations require the development and annual endorsement of a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for each urbanized area by the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

WHEREAS, In accordance with 23 CFR 450.334(a) the Brown County Planning Commission (BCPC) hereby certifies that the metropolitan transportation planning process is addressing major issues facing the metropolitan planning area and is being conducted in accordance with all applicable requirements of:

- 1. 23 U.S.C. 134 and 49 U.S.C. 5303, and this subpart;
- 2. Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended (42 U.S.C 2000d-1) and 49 CFR part 21;
- 3. 49 U.S.C. 5332, prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed, and national origin, in employment or business opportunity;
- 4. Sections 1101(b) of the FAST Act (P.L. 114-357) and 49 CFR Part 26 regarding the involvement of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in the US DOT funded projects;
- 5. 23 CFR part 230, regarding the implementation of an equal employment opportunity program on Federal and Federal-aid highway construction contracts;
- 6. The provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.) and 49 CFR Parts 27, 37, and 38;
- 7. The Older Americans Act, as amended (42 U.S.C 6101), prohibiting discrimination on the basis of age in programs or activities receiving Federal financial assistance;
- 8. Section 324 of title 23, U.S.C regarding the prohibition of discrimination based on gender; and
- 9. Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794) and 49 CFR 27 regarding discrimination against individuals with disabilities

WHEREAS, the BCPC is the designated MPO for the Green Bay Urbanized Area with responsibility for carrying out an urban transportation planning program; and

WHEREAS, the BCPC Board of Directors is the Green Bay MPO's policy board.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the BCPC Board of Directors approves the Mid-Year Update - Amendment #1 to the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for the Green Bay Urbanized Area.

NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the MPO planning process is compliant with the requirements of the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act) and that the BCPC certifies that the urban transportation planning process certification requirements of 23 CFR 450.114 (c) are satisfied.

Amendment Request

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) requested that the Brown County Planning Commission Board of Directors/Green Bay MPO amend the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Green Bay Urbanized Area to reflect federal funding assigned to two new projects located within the Green Bay MPO boundary. In addition, WisDOT provided revised funding estimates for a number of projects already identified in the TIP.

Projects:

<u>West Mason Street</u>. The project includes the design and replacement of a box culvert at the Beaver Dam Creek Bridge on West Mason Street in the City of Green Bay. Design work is scheduled for 2017 and construction is scheduled for 2021.

<u>Main Avenue/Reid Street</u>. The project includes design work for the future reconstruction of Main Avenue/Reid Street (one-way pair) from 3rd Street to 8th Street in the City of De Pere. Design work is scheduled for 2017.

Public Comment Period and Public Hearing

MPO staff conducted a 15-day public comment period and a public hearing was held on April 5, 2017. The public participation documents can be seen in the appendices of this amendment report.

Fiscal Constraint Demonstration

The projects contained in Amendment #1 to the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program for the Green Bay Urbanized Area are fiscally constrained as per federal requirements.

Transportation Subcommittee members were provided the draft amendment document. No comments were received.

BCPC Board of Directors (MPO Policy Board)

4. Public Hearing: Major Amendment #1 to the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Green Bay Urbanized Area.

L. Conard opened the public hearing for the Draft Major Amendment #1 to the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Green Bay Urbanized Area.

L. Conard described the proposed amendment before opening the floor for comment.

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation has requested the addition of two projects to the 2017 program, necessitating the need for the amendment. They include:

- 1. Design work for a box culvert replacement at Beaver Dam Creek at West Mason Street in the City of Green Bay.
- 2. Design work on Main Avenue/Reid Street from 3rd to 8th in the City of De Pere.

In addition, WisDOT has provided cost revisions to a number of projects already in the TIP.

D. Wiese noted that staff presents TIP amendments several times throughout the year and asked if amendments could be saved and presented less often.

L. Conard noted that WisDOT requested that an amendment be processed as soon as possible so that WisDOT could initiate the design work on the West Mason Street and Main Avenue/Reid Street projects. In order to initiate the design work, WisDOT is required to obtain a project number from the MPO. In order for MPO staff to provide this number to WisDOT, the Brown County Planning Commission/MPO Policy Board must amend the TIP.

Projects that already appear in the TIP but require only an amendment related to the cost estimate, are less time sensitive for WisDOT and can be presented to the board at the Mid-Year or Annual TIP update.

L. Conard asked three times if anyone else wished to speak. Hearing no comment, L. Conard closed the public hearing.

5. Discussion and action on the Major Amendment #1 to the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Green Bay Urbanized Area.

A motion was made by G. Pahl and seconded by M. Harris to approve the Major Amendment #1 to the 2017-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Green Bay Urbanized Area. Motion carried.
